



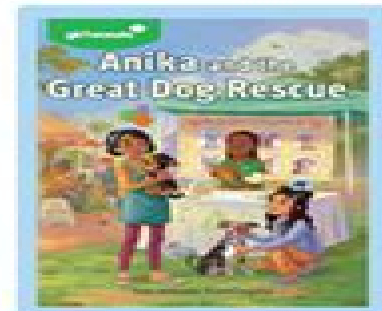
## Discussion Guide
