The Silver Queen (5) in the picture belongs to Colchester Corporation and was made as the official standard of the time the Colchester men could before they are gathered. Beside are two wild flowers of the Essex, saffron, Sea Lavender (6) and Sea Aster (7). Indeed the class of Rivers are celebrated for heathland trees (8) - pollarded hornbeams are characteristic of Rivington Forest, from the glades of which the poet John Clare used to see London "like a ghost among the hills" (9) and for the tree Oakly (10) of woods and copse, which is either larger and more pallid than the country. Notice on the right the Silverheads (10), which are common above the root of some of the older trees along the Essex coast.
