Flower: makes seeds for reproduction

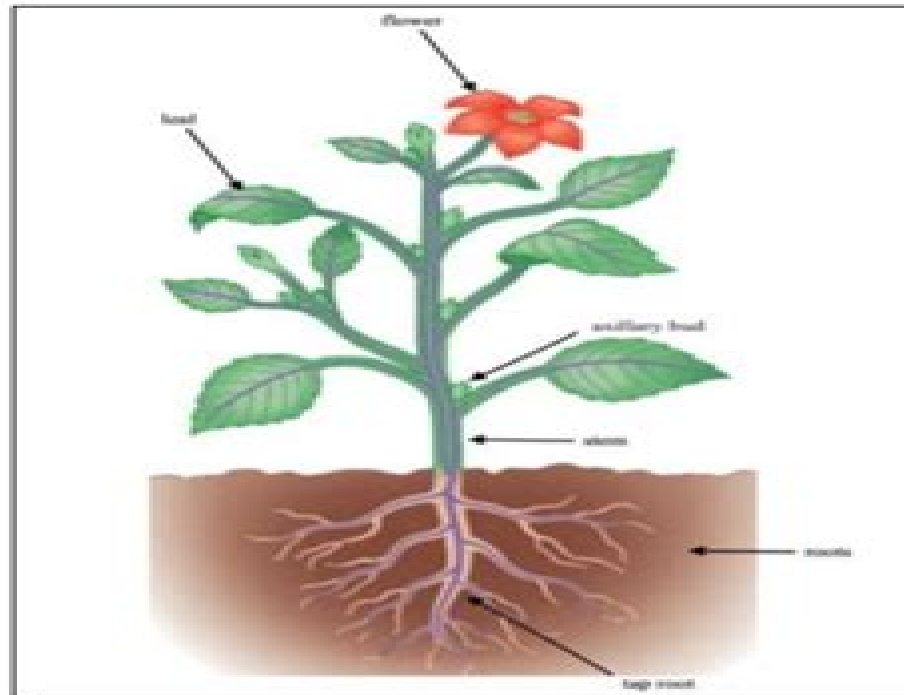
Axillary bud: a bud that develops on the axil (looks like a tiny leaf or tiny closed flower bud)
