

Seventh-day Adventist Sabbath School Bible Study Guide for the First Quarter of 2022

This is a review of the entire Seventh-day Adventist Adult Teachers Sabbath School Bible Study Guide (SBSBG) for the first quarter of 2022 under the Theme Last Days: the Message of Holiness.¹ In this SBSBG, eight different Bibles were used two of which are Roman Catholic Bibles. I counted the number of times each was used. I did not count them twice as they could be off a little. I did not count Bibles quoted in quotations from various books. When a text support of a verse was quoted that would have been there were marked without any indication of what version it was from, I didn't count it. The numbers were as follows:

New King James Version (NKJV): 14.
King James Version (KJV): 1.
New American Standard Bible (NASB): 16.
New Revised Standard Version (NRSV): 143.
New International Version (NIV): 11.
English Standard Version (ESV): 44.
Anchor's Translation (Greek, study): 2.
Total: 1

One security note was from the NKJV, one was from the NIV, one was from the ESV and one could have been from either the new Bible (name about that later).

The NKJV and ESV are Roman Catholic Bibles. Except for the KJV, the rest of the Bibles are essentially Roman Catholic Bibles though as the best of my knowledge, they never received the official approval of the Roman Catholic Church.

Page numbers referenced will be as in the standard Bibles of the SBSBG, unless otherwise noted.
