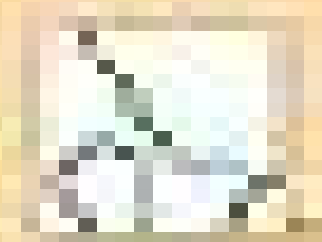

The best way for consolidating the team knowledge and experience is bedside teaching. New methods and approaches of neonatal management are progressing but seem to slow down over the last 2-3 years. This may reflect the fact neonatal advances are approaching our era peak of what is possible. Nevertheless, many of our current practices are yet to be scrutinized to fulfil the evidence-based pathways and standards. There is no robust verification of our current practice of many routine day-to-day applications. This includes but is not limited to fluid requirements, duration of antibiotics courses, use of various blood products and seizures pharmacological treatment. I have reviewed multiple neonatal medical and nursing guidelines from Europe, North America and Australia as well as guidelines from Asia, South America and Africa. I integrated many aspects from these guidelines within this text whenever they are in accord with the international acceptable practices.
