Chest Pain of Recent Onset, 2010 Chest pain or discomfort caused by acute coronary syndromes ACS or angina has a potentially poor prognosis emphasising the importance of prompt and accurate diagnosis Treatments are available to improve symptoms and prolong life hence the need for this guideline This guideline covers the assessment and diagnosis of people with recent onset chest pain or discomfort of suspected cardiac origin In deciding whether chest pain may be cardiac and therefore whether this guideline is relevant a number of factors should be taken into account These include the person's history of chest pain their cardiovascular risk factors history of ischaemic heart disease and any previous treatment and previous investigations for chest pain For pain that is suspected to be cardiac there are two separate diagnostic pathways presented in the guideline The first is for people with acute chest pain in whom ACS is suspected and the second is for people with intermittent stable
