Interactions between objects often involve forces. These forces include gravity, electric, and magnetic forces among phenomena.

Gravity is a universally attractive force that acts in the down-but far as infinite range, meaning it can happen between anything in the air, in space, objects, planets, and the distance between them is always noticeable.

Electric and magnetic forces are components of the electromagnetic force, acting on repelling or attracting charged objects, according to repelling or attracting objects with a charge. It becomes magnetic forces are observed in everyday magnetic phenomena, such as magnets, electric currents, and forces at work.

Scientists determine the direction of these forces by observing the direction of change in the position of the force. These forces are considered relative to strength of force at the distance, such as force at large distances.
