He asserted that people's self-understanding is constructed, in part, by their perception of how others view them – a process term "the looking glass self".</p> <p>Sociologist Charles Horton Cooley introduced the looking-glass self to highlight that the people whom a person interacts become a mirror in which he views himself.</p> <p>The looking Glass Self (Cooley, 1902)</p>	Students will give their insights about sociological perspective of self.
