Popup Calendar for AcroForms

Currently, there is no really good way to create a general purpose popup calendar for use with Acrobat Forms, but there are still a couple of ways that it can be done. The calendar presented here is composed entirely of Acrobat Form Fields and controlled through JavaScript. It was first developed a very long time ago by Jesper Thomsen at Trisect Development in Denmark (www.trisect.dk), who provides it for free. It has been touched by several developers since then, and a few have even tried to port it. The version presented here was modified by David Conorozzo at FormRoster (www.formroster.com), and I consider the very best. It is much faster, and easier to use than the original. I further modified the code to handle popups in Internet Explorer, which the original developer's code did not.
