Captions	Small text near a picture that tells information.	
Labels	Words that tell about a specific part of a picture or diagram.	
Bold Print	Words that are bolder (dark) are very important to the topic.	
Diagram	A labeled picture that shows the parts of something.	
Charts	Charts show a lot of information in a small space.	
Index	A list of important words in the book.
