As architectural publication developed and grew more sophisticated it played an increasingly prominent part in the design and the construction of domestic buildings. Through the use of published designs they were able to choose among a variety of plans, styles and individual motifs and engage in a fruitful dialogue with past and present architects. *Houses from Books* reconstructs this dialogue by examining the links between the published designs and the houses themselves.
