Begin the entry with the author's last name, followed by a comma and the rest of the name, as presented in the work.

The title of the source should follow the author's name. Depending upon the type of source, it should be listed in italics or quotation marks.

Last name, First name. "Article Title or Individual Section of The Page." Website Title,

Name of the Publisher, Publication Date in Day Month Year formatting, URL.

The MLA 8 edition also added the rule of including both volume and number of journal publications like "Vol.24, no.3".

The city of publication is not necessary

Always make sure to include the complete address for a web-site except for the HTTP part.
