

Aloha Takeout Guest Management Screen



- 1 **Dashboard** — Holds general information about order promise and ready times, and contains a configurable message.
- 2 **Caller ID lines** — Shows the phone number for each customer currently calling in an order.
- 3 **Search bar** — Allows you to search for customers already in the database, by phone number or name. Also useful for starting a new customer record.
- 4 **Sort tabs** — Allows you to sort customers by name, phone number, or zip code.
- 5 **Order mode buttons** — Select from Walk In, Call Up, Delivery, or Curbside order modes.
- 6 **Count per order type** — Shows the number of open takeout or delivery orders in the current business day.

- 7 **Order summary panel** — Provides information about the currently selected customer and their most recent order. Contains buttons that enable you to edit customer information or add a new customer, and for repeating a previous order or for starting a new order. Panel appears automatically when needed, or when manually selected.
- 8 **Customer search results panel** — Lists all customers found meeting the search criteria.
- 9 **Delayed Order button** — Enables you to create an order for preparation later than the normal promise time, from a few minutes to a maximum of five years.
- 10 **Navigation buttons** — Provide access to the Order Management screen, or the Aloha POS screens.

Working with Guest Records



Touch a **Caller ID** button to search by phone number, or start typing the **customer name** to search by name. The search results panel changes as you type, to display customers that match. Touch the **correct name**, when found. Use the scroll bar to see more names.



Touch **Add Guest** to add a new guest record, or **Edit Guest** to edit an existing guest record. An onscreen keyboard appears, allowing you to type customer information. Touch **Tab** to move from one text box to the next. Touch the **tabs** in the **Customer Data** screen to add different types of information about the guest.



Touch **Repeat Order** to start a new order identical to the last order shown. This button accesses the Aloha order entry screen, with the items from the previous order already selected. You can place the order as-is, or modify it as needed.


