**PREVENTION:** Statements meant to prevent harm.

**STORAGE:** Statements regarding safe storage.

**DISPOSAL:** Statements concerning disposal practices.

**1. IDENTIFICATION:** This section is informative. It is the responsibility of the manufacturer to determine if the hazard statements apply to the product. The manufacturer is responsible for the accuracy and completeness of the information.

**2. HAZARD(S) IDENTIFICATION:** This section lists hazard(s) that may result from exposure to the product.

**3. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS:** This section identifies the ingredients that make up the product. The percentage of each ingredient is also listed.

**4. FIRST-AID MEASURES:** This section describes what medical care must be given for potential emergencies that are most likely to occur.

**5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES:** This section provides recommendations for fighting fires involving the product.

**6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES:** This section provides recommendations for other types of emergencies, such as spills, leaks, or overexposure to the product. It also includes information on what must be done to prevent the product from causing further damage.

**7. HANDLING AND STORAGE:** This section provides recommendations for safe handling.

**8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION:** This section indicates that exposure limits, engineering controls, and personal protective measures must be used to protect workers from exposure.

**9. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES:** This section describes physical and chemical properties of the product, such as its reactivity or instability.

**10. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY:** This section describes whether the chemical is stable or reactive under normal conditions. This section includes data on thermal stability, chemical stability, and others.

**11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** This section includes information about health effects, information on carcinogens that health effects are most susceptible, and other toxicological information.

**12. ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION:** This section provides information on the effects of the product on the environment.


**13. DISPOSAL INFORMATION:** This section provides information on disposal practices.

**14. TRANSPORT INFORMATION:** This section provides information on shipping a product.

**15. REGULATORY INFORMATION:** This section identifies laws, regulations, and other requirements that must be followed when shipping a product.

**16. OTHER INFORMATION:** This section is intended to provide additional information that is not covered in the other sections. It may include information on other hazard types, recommended controls, or important uses of the product.

## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR A CHEMICAL LABEL



**1. GHS Pictograms:** Standardized symbols which convey health, physical, and environmental hazard information.

**2. Product Identifier:** Name or number used for a hazardous product in the SDS.

**3. Signal Words:** "Danger" or "Warning" are used to emphasize hazards and indicate the relative level of severity of the hazard assigned to a GHS hazard class and category.

**4. Hazard Statements:** Standard phrases assigned to a hazard class and category that describe the nature of the hazard.

**5. Precautionary Statements:** Measures to minimize or prevent adverse effects.

**6. Supplier Identification:** Company name, address, and phone number should be listed on the label.
