- 1 Establish and follow a comprehensive safety plan
- 2 Provide and ensure the use of appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE)
- 3 Ensure all employees receive proper training on safety procedures and equipment use
- 4 Implement and enforce safety protocols for emergency situations
- 5 Maintain clean and organized work areas to prevent accidents
- 6 Regularly inspect and maintain equipment and machinery
- 7 Clearly mark and keep emergency exits and evacuation routes accessible
- 8 Promote and enforce safe lifting and material handling practices
- 9 Report and investigate all incidents and near-misses to prevent recurrence
- 10 Follow all relevant OSHA standards and regulations

The term designated personnel means selected or assigned by the employer or the employer's representative as being qualified to perform specific duties. These requirements reflect OSHA's belief that training is an essential part of every employer's safety and health
