PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

PREVENTION: Statements meant to prevent harm.

STORAGE: Statements regarding safe storage.

DISPOSAL: Statements concerning disposal practices.

1. IDENTIFICATION: This section is informative. It is the responsibility of the manufacturer to determine if the hazard statements apply to the product. The manufacturer must assign the hazard statements to the product.

2. HAZARD(S) IDENTIFICATION: This section lists hazard statements that describe the potential hazards of the product.

3. COMPOSITION/INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS: This section identifies the ingredients that make up the product. The product is made up of individual ingredients, each having its own hazard statement.

4. FIRST-AID MEASURES: This section describes what medical care must be given for potential emergencies that are most likely to occur.

5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES: This section provides recommendations for fighting fires involving the product.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES: This section provides recommendations for other types of emergencies, such as spills, leaks, or overexposure to the product. It also includes information on what must be done to reduce the risk of health hazards.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE: This section provides recommendations for safe handling.

8. EXPOSURE CONTROLS/PERSONAL PROTECTION: This section indicates that exposure limits, engineering controls, and personal protective measures must be used to protect health and safety.

9. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL PROPERTIES: This section describes physical and chemical properties of the product, such as its reactivity or instability.

10. STABILITY AND REACTIVITY: This section describes whether the chemical is stable or reactive under normal conditions. This section includes data on thermal stability, chemical stability, and others.

11. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: This section includes information on health effects, information on carcinogens that health effects are most susceptible.

12. ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION: This section gives information concerning the effects of the product on the environment.


13. DISPOSAL INFORMATION: This section provides information on disposal practices, including product residues, containers, and disposal of empty containers.

14. TRANSPORT INFORMATION: This section provides information on shipping a product, including shipping names, hazard class, and hazard labels.

15. REGULATORY INFORMATION: This section identifies laws, regulations, and other requirements that must be followed when shipping a product.

16. OTHER INFORMATION: This section is intended to provide additional information that is not covered in the other sections. The manufacturer may include other information, such as physical properties, that is not required by the hazard statements. Other information may include the following: hazard classification, hazard communication update, recommendations for information required by the hazard statement, other hazard statements, hazard statements for other products, and hazard statements for other products.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR A SAFETY DATA SHEET



1. **GHS Pictograms:** Standardized symbols which convey health, physical, and environmental hazard information.
2. **Product Identifier:** Name or number used for a hazardous product in the SDS.
3. **Signal Words:** "Danger" or "Warning" are used to emphasize hazards and indicate the relative level of severity of the hazard assigned to a GHS hazard class and category.
4. **Hazard Statements:** Standard phrases assigned to a hazard class and category that describe the nature of the hazard.
5. **Precautionary Statements:** Measures to minimize or prevent adverse effects.
6. **Supplier Identification:** Company name, address, and phone number should be listed on the label.
