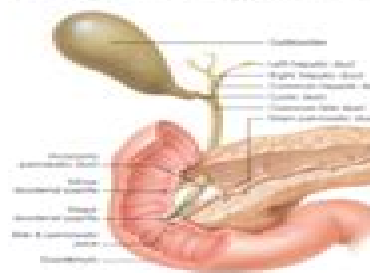
What is the digestive system?

The digestive system, or **gastrointestinal tract**, is a tract of organs that is used to break down food into nutrients that can be absorbed by the body. The digestive system is a complex system that includes the mouth, salivary glands, stomach, small intestine, large intestine, and rectum. The digestive system is a continuous tube that starts in the mouth and ends in the rectum. The organs of the digestive system are located in the abdominal cavity.

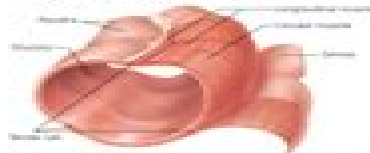


Liver, pancreas & gallbladder

After leaving the stomach, chyme moves into the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine, where it is mixed with bile secreted by the **liver** and pancreatic juice secreted by the **pancreas**. This acts as a strong agent on the chyme, while the duodenum's own secretions (secretory digests) support further breakdown. The liver also produces bile, which is stored in the **gallbladder**.

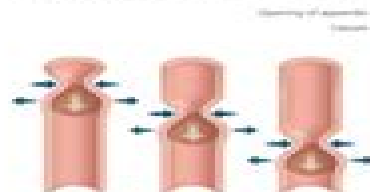


Layers of large intestine



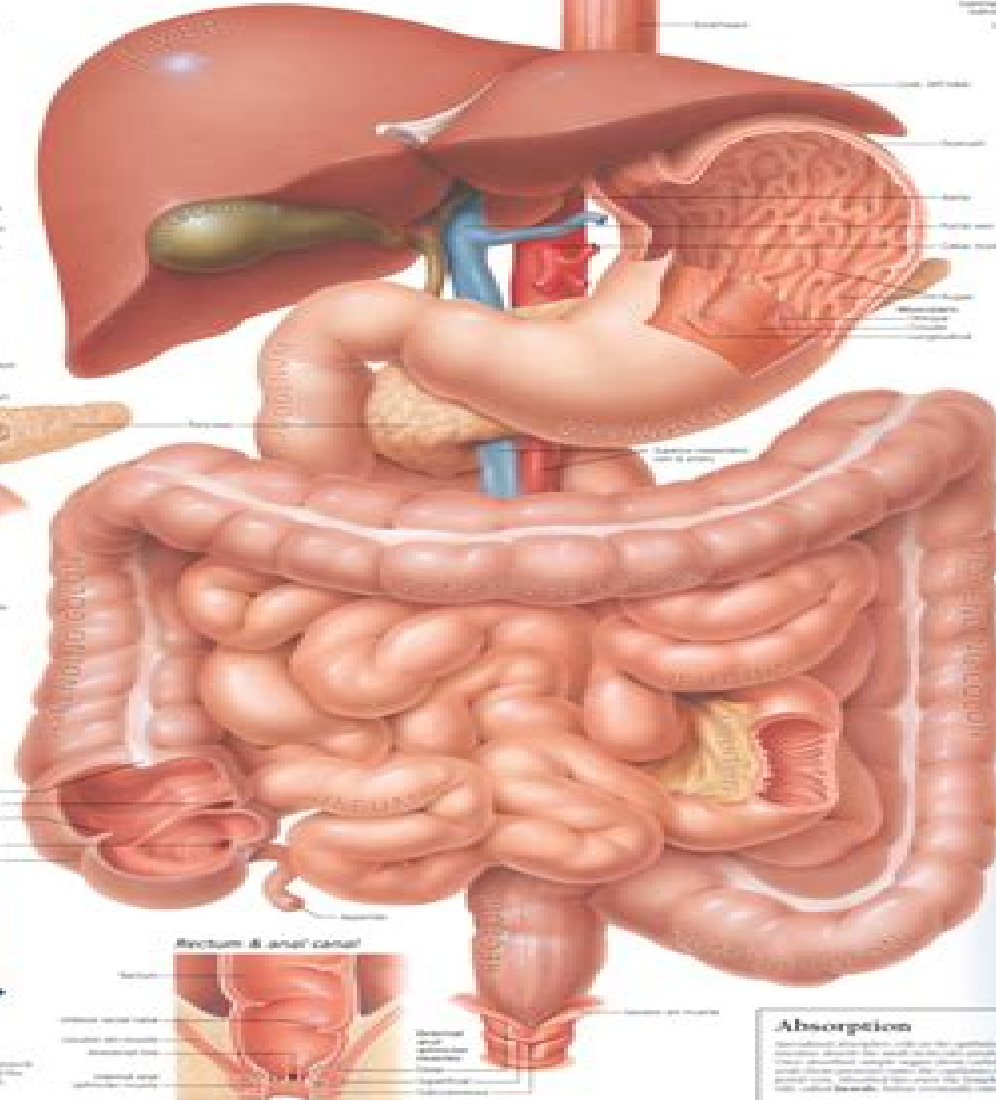
Large intestine

The large intestine consists of the cecum, the caecum, the ascending colon, the transverse colon, the descending colon, the sigmoid colon, and the rectum. The large intestine is responsible for the absorption of water and electrolytes from the undigested food. It also produces and stores feces.



Peristaltic action

Food material is pushed through the digestive system by a series of powerful muscular contractions called peristalsis. These contractions move the material forward and the food is then, when the stomach has relaxed.



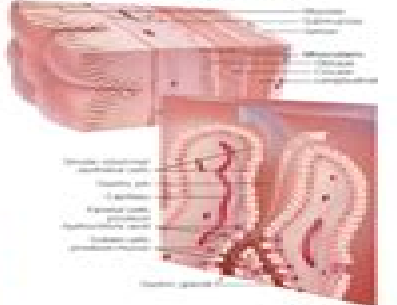
The mouth & salivary glands

Chewing the food breaks it into smaller pieces, making it easier to swallow. Saliva, secreted by the salivary glands, moistens the food and helps in the digestion of starch. Saliva also contains the enzyme amylase, which begins the digestion of starch. The food is then swallowed and moves down the esophagus to the stomach.



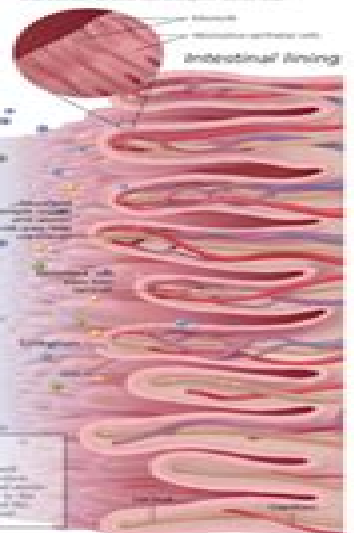
The stomach

The stomach is a large, muscular organ that is responsible for the digestion of food. It is located in the upper left part of the abdominal cavity. The stomach has a thick, muscular wall that contracts to mix food with gastric juices. The stomach also has a pyloric sphincter that controls the passage of food into the small intestine.



Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, coiled tube that is responsible for the digestion of food. It is located in the lower part of the abdominal cavity. The small intestine has a highly folded inner lining called villi, which increases the surface area for the absorption of nutrients. The small intestine is divided into three parts: the duodenum, the jejunum, and the ileum.



Absorption

The nutrients from the food are absorbed into the blood and lymphatic system. The absorption of nutrients occurs in the small intestine. The nutrients are then transported to the liver, where they are processed and stored. The liver also produces bile, which is used to digest fat.
