5 STEPS TO PERFORMING CPR

1 ASSESS SCENE SAFETY



Check your surroundings for safety. If you are in danger, call 9-1-1 first.

2 CHECK FOR RESPONSIVENESS



Ask, "Are you okay?" Tap other person's shoulder and shout, "Are you okay?"

3 LOOK FOR NORMAL BREATHING



Look for normal chest rise and fall.

4 CALL 9-1-1



If no response, call 9-1-1. If you are alone, start CPR immediately. If someone else is available, have them call 9-1-1 and get an AED if available.

5 START CPR



Use hands only CPR. If available, use an AED.

3 CONTINUE SETS OF 5 BACK BLOWS AND 5 CHEST THRUSTS UNTIL:

This patient can drink or eat.
This patient is not in shock.

1 CHECK FOR BREATHING AND A PULSE



2 IF NO PULSE, START CPR



3 RESCUE BREATHS



4 CONTINUE COMPRESSIONS UNTIL:

This patient is found well.
This patient can cough, breathe, or move.
This patient can drink or eat.
This patient is not in shock.

CONTINUE COMPRESSION OR 30 COMPRESSIONS AND 2 BREATHS UNTIL:

- The victim begins to breathe.
- An AED is ready to use.
- A trained rescuer arrives.
- You are too exhausted to continue.
