5 STEPS TO PERFORMING CPR

1 ASSESS SCENE SAFETY



Check the area for any safety hazards that may be harmful to you

2 CHECK FOR RESPONSIVENESS



Tap the victim's shoulder and shout, "Are you OK?"

3 LOOK FOR NORMAL BREATHING



Look for normal chest rise and fall

4 CALL 9-1-1



If no response, call 9-1-1 or your emergency responder. If you are alone, you must call 9-1-1 first and then return to the victim.

5 START CPR



If not breathing and no response, start CPR.

ADULT

STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM ADULT CPR (18 YEARS+)

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
 - Push hard
 - Push fast
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
 - Head-tilt, chin-lift
 - Pinch nose
 - Give 2 breaths

Repeat the cycle until help arrives, but always recommended for child and infant CPR

CHILD

STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM CHILD CPR (1 YEAR - 12 YEARS)

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
 - Use 1 or 2 hands depending on the size of the child
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
 - Head-tilt, chin-lift
 - Pinch nose
 - Give 2 breaths

INFANT

STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM INFANT CPR (0 - 1 YEAR)

- 1. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
 - Use 2 fingers
 - Push hard, push fast
- 2. GIVE 2 RESCUE BREATHS**
 - Head-tilt, chin-lift
 - Pinch nose
 - Give 2 breaths

PET

STEPS FOR HOW TO PERFORM PET CPR

- 1. CHECK FOR BREATHING AND A PULSE**
 - Check pulse: Artery where your pulse, where it beats. If no pulse, start CPR.
- 2. GIVE 30 CHEST COMPRESSIONS**
 - Use 1 or 2 hands depending on the size of the pet
- 3. IF NO PULSE, START CPR**
 - Give 2 rescue breaths
 - Give 30 chest compressions
- 4. RESCUE BREATHS**
 - Head-tilt, chin-lift
 - Pinch nose
 - Give 2 breaths

STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING ADULT

- 1. GIVE CONTINUOUS ABDOMINAL THRUSTS**
 - Place a fist with the thumb side against the middle of the victim's abdomen, just above the navel
 - Cover your fist with your other hand
- 2. CONTINUE ABDOMINAL THRUSTS UNTIL:**
 - The object is forced out
 - The victim can cough, breathe or breathe
 - The victim becomes unconscious
 - Call 9-1-1 if not alone

STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING CHILD

- 1. GIVE CONTINUOUS ABDOMINAL THRUSTS**
 - Place a fist with the thumb side against the middle of the child's abdomen, just above the navel
 - Cover your fist with your other hand
- 2. CONTINUE ABDOMINAL THRUSTS UNTIL:**
 - The object is forced out
 - The child can cough, breathe or breathe
 - The child becomes unconscious
 - Call 9-1-1 if not alone

INFANT

STEPS FOR HOW TO HELP A CONSCIOUS CHOKING INFANT

- 1. GIVE 5 BACK BLOWS**
 - Place the infant on your forearm, with their head lower than their chest
- 2. GIVE 5 CHEST THRUSTS**
 - Place the infant on your forearm, with their head lower than their chest

★ CONTINUE COMPRESSION OR 30 COMPRESSIONS AND 2 BREATHS UNTIL:



- The victim begins to breathe
- An AED is ready to use
- A trained rescuer arrives
- You are too exhausted to continue
