Chap 1 | New World Beginnings

33,000 BCE - 1769 CE

- Around 10 million years ago, nature sculpted the basic geological shape of North America, which was anchored in its northeastern corner by a massive **Canadian Shield**, a zone supported by an ancient rock.
- The Great Ice Age began around 2 million years ago when 2-mile-thick ice sheets blanketed parts of Europe, Asia, and the Americas.
- **Berling Land Bridge**
 - Around 35,000 years ago, the Ice Age lowered the sea level, exposing the **Great Berling Land Bridge**, which connected Eurasia with North America.
 - Allowed migratory herds and small bands of hunters to make their way to the Americas.
 - When the Ice Age ended and the glaciers melted, sea levels rose again, covering the bridge.
- **Incas** in Peru
- **Mayans** in Central America
- **Aztecs** in Mexico believed that in order to obtain the favor of their gods, they would have to offer human sacrifices. They often cut the hearts of chests of living victims, who were commonly captives conquered in battle. There were more than 5000 people routinely slaughtered to celebrate the crowning of one Aztec chieftain (head/leader).
- The Earliest American agriculture was dependent on corn. It was the foundation of Aztec and Incan civilizations, transforming nomadic hunting bands into settled agricultural villages. If a society exists, it's because of corn. If a society does not exist, it's because they didn't have corn.
- Less elaborately developed societies with no dense concentrations of population were called **nation-states**.
- **The Mississippian**
 - The Mississippians were based on hunting and agriculture, building mounds for religious and residential purposes.
 - **Cahokia**, the largest city of the Mississippians, was a trading hub and home to as many as 25,000 people.
