Before installing Your Cable Modem

Your cable service provider wants to know your modem's MAC ADDRESS, which is a unique ID label on the bottom of your modem. This information identifies your cable modem device as a Cable Modem/Router to the Internet service provider (ISP) and the cable service provider. To obtain this information, go to the bottom of the cable modem's main panel and locate a label that contains the modem's model name and number, which is **CM1080M**. If you need the modem's serial number, you can find it from the MAC address on the modem's label.

System Requirements

- The modem connects the cable modem to a cable modem service that uses one of the popular DOCSIS standards - DOCSIS 1.1, 2.0, or 3.1. If you need to get cable modem service, please speak with your cable service provider.
- To use the Quick Start, you need a computer, an iPod™, or another tablet.

If your cable service provider provided a cable modem starter kit, please confirm with them that you have your cable modem. The kit may include a modem cable for connecting your modem to your cable service. (The cable may include a modem-to-modem cable or a modem-to-router cable, depending on the modem.) The modem also includes a DOCSIS address.
