

welfare approach known as Looking After Children developed in the UK in the late 1980s and 1990s to reform and improve services to vulnerable young people who were being looked after in out of home care. When launched in 2000 the OnLAC project Canadianized the UK approach and partnered with the Ontario Association of Children's Aid Societies (OACAS) and some 20 children's aid societies in the province. Since 2007 the Ontario government has mandated that local societies use the OnLAC method to plan services and monitor outcomes.
