Succession may be initiated either by formation of new unoccupied habitat such as from a lava flow or a severe landslide or by some form of disturbance of a community such as from a fire, severe windthrow or logging. Succession that begins in new habitats uninfluenced by pre-existing communities is called primary succession, whereas succession that follows disruption of a pre-existing community is called secondary succession.
