Types of Inventory

1. Raw Materials (RAW)
 - a. Inputs into manufacturing
 - b. Normally longest lead time inventory type
 - c. Valued at standard cost while in inventory (what was paid for them)
2. Work in Process (WIP)
 - a. Material in various stages of completion
 - b. Value includes direct labor hours and overhead.
3. Finished Goods (FG)
 - a. Completed part
 - b. Sold to the customer – external or internal (e.g. a different division)
 - c. Stored at either the production facility, warehouse, or distribution center
4. Maintenance, Repair, and Operating Supplies (MRO)
 - a. Large quantities but low cost
 - b. Include office and custodial supplies
 - c. Maintenance and spare parts
 - d. Replenishment: visual review, use and replace, reorder point
