

Points of the Arm Tai Yin Lung Channel

General	The lung channel starts on the lateral chest near the xiphoid process and travels up the chest slightly before entering the upper limb. It then descends the anterior aspect of the limb towards the thumb, where it ends on the radial side of the thumb itself. It has 11 points. It is grouped with the Large Intestine under the Metal element in the element theory.
More specifically	Originating in the Middle Jiao/plexus, the channel is said to have three divisions with the Large Intestine (its Yang channel segment), and segments, through the diaphragm, spreading through the lungs, bladder and large intestine, emerging at Lung 9 just below the lateral end of the clavicle and inferior to the xiphoid process. Lung 1 is above the xiphoid process and the channel then travels downwards along thorax, through the costal area, past the elbow and radial deviation of the hand and then varying slightly laterally towards the thumb at the radial styloid. It finishes on the radial side of the base of the thumb.
Area innervated	Clav., Anterior Arm + Antero-Lateral Thorax.
Area affected with treatment	1-6-8 segmental lymph, lungs, chest, Upper Jiao/plexus, Throat and large intestine (like conditions bronchial/colon).

Reassessing the near vicinity of the 10th rib to the 10th intercostal muscle should always be oblique and lateral.

Location

On the anterior lateral aspect of the chest, approximately 1 cm inferior and slightly lateral to LU 2, just medial to the xiphoid process of the scapula. Located in the pectoralis major muscle and, more deeply, in the muscle of the pectoralis minor. Also, medially in its deep portion, the muscle of the lateral intercostal space (CF-CE), or the body of the ribs, depending on the individual structures of the 10th rib and the shoulder girdle.

To aid location, ask the patient to shrug the arm and forward flex the shoulder to emphasize the pectoralis and anterior deltoid muscles. Then, locate LU 1 at the corner of the depression of the deltoidpectoral triangle, and then, following the
